Nowadays women can study, vote, work and, most important of all, they can choose. But, not so long ago, in many places the birth of a girl was a disgrace: she was only another girl to marry off. Nowadays, being a woman is not a disgrace.

However, I think that women only appear to be free. There are few women managers and usually their jobs are connected to the 'woman's world' (fashion, cosmetics, women's magazines, etc.). On TV, for example, there are not many women journalists and they often owe their jobs to their beautiful faces, not to their heads – despite the fact that, according to an opinion poll, many audiences (for example Italians) actually prefer women on TV.

It is no longer enough to regard the women's world as a bad photocopy of the men's. The big battle of this century is, I think, to make the apparent freedom a reality: women must discover their own identity. I hope that the society of males and females will be an equal world. It's unrealistic to think that women can become the centre of the world and men simply satellites. But we still have some way to go towards a better balance.
