Dr. Arthur Wilson, 54, scientist of Holy Trinity University in Shaw, Oldham, took up 'surfing' the Internet after his first wife died. He was feeling lonely, so he looked for friendship through the Internet Relay Fifties Chat Channel and his message was answered by Jenny Rusdell, a former head teacher at a girls' boarding school.

Jenny and I first met on the Internet about a year ago, and we met in person or the first time in February.'

What he remembers mainly about their first real meeting is that Jenny prepared a delicious meal for him! Since then they have been keeping in touch in a more traditional way – by phone. 'I hate to think what the telephone bill is now,' he said.
